Thank you for participating in our annual Craft Bazaar supporting blind and visually impaired athletes at the Washington State School for the Blind.

As you may know, the State of Washington Legislation has recently updated the statute RCW 82.32.033 which requires special event promoters to verify that vendors are registered to do business with the Washington State Department of Revenue.

As a result of the above update, we are asking our vendors to provide tax identification numbers and/or Unified Business Identifiers (UBI) on our registration form. If you do not have a tax identification number or UBI, please contact the Department of Revenue at 1-866-248-1287 to obtain a **FREE** temporary permit. (Please Note: Temporary permits are only available by phone. Online applications will not process properly for temporary requests.) This does not mean you are starting an official business with the State of Washington.
